TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BOOKING

- 1) All schools must pay the full balance on or before the date of the visit. Cheques, cash, and credit/debit cards are accepted. An invoice may be raised with prior arrangement and must be settled in full before the date of visit. A £25 non-refundable deposit is payable to secure your booking.
- 2) Classroom times cannot be altered. Please ensure you leave plenty of time for your journey and plan your classroom times carefully. Times given must be strictly adhered to. Late arrival may result in classes being re-scheduled or even cancelled and must still be paid for.
- 3) It is not possible to offer face painting to schools or large groups
- 4) Limited space is available for packed lunches and cannot be guaranteed, especially during busy periods. However if we are notified in advance we will do our best to accommodate you. Where possible the groups will be allocated a dedicated time slot in an authorised area where lunches can be eaten. Lunch slots are 20 minutes and must be strictly adhered to.
- 5) Deep Sea World reserves the right to alter or cancel the classroom sessions without notice if operational or other reasons requires us to do so.
- 6) The consumption of any food or drinks is only permitted in authorised areas by Deep Sea World. Under our Zoo License food and drink is not permitted in any part of the aquarium, including the outdoor seal sanctuary, with the exception of the café.
- 7) Deep Sea World cannot accept responsibility for any personal items either damaged or lost within the attraction or surrounding grounds or car park other than the circumstances covered by our Public Liability Insurance.
- 8) Deep Sea World reminds its visitors that there may be times due to operations reasons that certain exhibits, attractions or facilities may be unavailable.
- 9) Deep Sea World operates a no smoking policy throughout the attraction, except for designated outdoor areas.
- 10) All groups are advised to take out their personal insurance for out-of-school visits and activities.
- 11) Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times throughout the attraction.
